Superintendent's Report

Dr. Ernest Palestis proudly announced to the community that the Morris Plains School District has been chosen to be a Choice School District. The district is accepting applications through November 2, 2012 for the 2013-2014 school year. The district applied for 36 seats in the lower grades. The district hopes to receive \$13,000 per student with a maximum income of \$468,000. Dr. Palestis encouraged everyone to spread the word. The district will be planning an open house. Our schools have a lot to offer students including physical appearance of facilities, good test scores and updated technology. Not only is this good for the community but for teachers as well in preventing loss of teacher jobs.

Dr. Palestis acknowledged the efforts of the business administrator, Mrs. Kristin Kosky for coordinating the summer projects for the district with the business office and facility staff.

WHEREAS, the opinion set forth that, when it is necessary for a Board to invoke the Doctrine of Necessity, the Board should state publicly that it is doing so, the reason that such action is necessary and the specific nature of the conflicts of interest; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the Legislative purpose as set forth in N.J.S.A. 18A:12-22(a), the School Ethics Commission views public disclosure of conflicts of interest to be paramount when it is necessary to invoke the Doctrine of Necessity;

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23B-1.1 et. seq. requires that each board of education adopt a formal policy and procedures relating to travel and expense reimbursement for its employees and board members; and

WHEREAS, the School District of the Morris Plains School District (the "Board") adopted a Travel Expense Reimbursement Policy that addresses the reimbursement of travel-related expenses by Board members and employees of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered all other relevant guidelines and circulars associated with the adoption of its Travel Expense Reimbursement Policy; and
