Dear Parent/Guardian of Morristown High School Students,

I hope you are all enjoying the summer break.

Attached to this letter is the bus schedule for your child for the 2016-2017 school year. Please note that the bus stops as well as the times are the same as they were last year. Educational Services Commission of Morris County (ESC) is in the process of bidding our routes for us. You will be informed of the bus company who will be transporting the students as soon as the bids have been awarded. The bus routes will also be placed on the Morris Plains School District web site: www.mpsdk8.org.

In the event you feel your child is not on the appropriate bus, please email me and I will make the adjustment if the bus stop is closer to your child's home. Bus drivers should not be asked to deviate from the scheduled bus route.

Please have your child at the appropriate bus stop five minutes before the scheduled pick up time. Initially, it will take a while for the students and the drivers to get used to the route. Your patience and cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

At the end of the school day, the buses will be parked in the circle on Early Street. The windows of the buses will display the route numbers so that the student can identify the appropriate bus based on the route number listed on his/her bus schedule. We have three buses going to the High School: HS-1/2, HS-3, and MP-4.

In the event you have a problem with the high school transportation (for example, if it appears that the bus is not arriving or is very late), please call the transportation office directly. The number of the contractor will be posted on the district web site as soon as the contractor has been awarded the bid. I will also check with the high school to see if they can send an alert to the parents.
